

Serving as a CHAMP Coach

Qualifications

- Must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ according to the Word of God (John 1:12; Romans 10:9-10; Ephesians 2:8-9).
- Must be an active participant in a local church.
- Must maintain a Christ-like attitude.
- Continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of God (both in and out of church).
- Must follow the overall mission and vision of CHAMP Sports Outreach.
- Must represent a healthy family situation
- Have a desire to impact children and families
- Have a basic knowledge of the sport and be willing to learn.
- Must be at least 21 to serve as a head coach
- Must be at least 18 to serve as an assistant coach. For those younger than 18, you may still may be an assistant coach; but you will not be able to hold a practice or coach a game alone. You will be paired with an experienced adult coach.

Expectations

- Set a Christ-like example. "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ." (1 Corinthians 11:1)
- Lead Bible Huddle Time (prayer & devotional).
- Be faithful, available, coachable and enthusiastic.
